

Analysis of the Number of DCVMN e-Learning Certificates Achieved per Person from December 1st, 2016 to December 31st, 2020



The DCVMN e-learning platform currently offers 23 courses to its members. Since 2016, 3823 participants have enrolled in e-learning courses, of which 1869 achieved certificates. A total of 870 people has completed certificates on the platform.

The table below shows the distribution of the number of certificates achieved per person on the DCVMN e-learning platform as of December 2020.

The majority of users of the e-learning platform (57.2%) earn one certificate. Furthermore, 20.5% and 10.7% of users obtain 2 or 3 certificates, respectively. Only a few achieve more than 7 certificates (3.6%), with two users obtaining the maximum number of certificates (22) in 2020.
